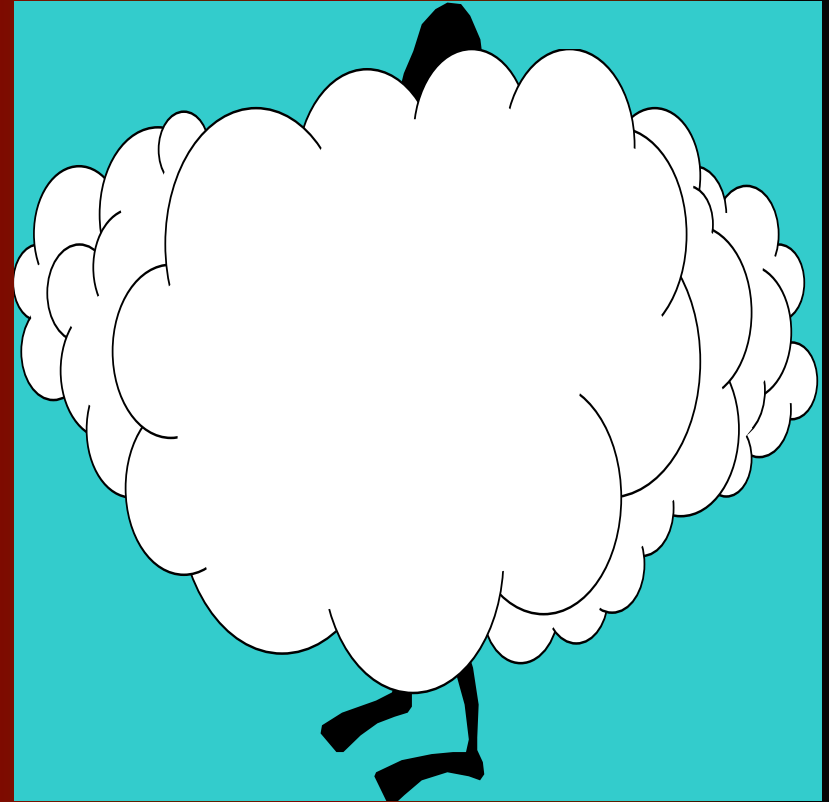


How I Became a **PRINCIPAL**

I went to COLLEGE

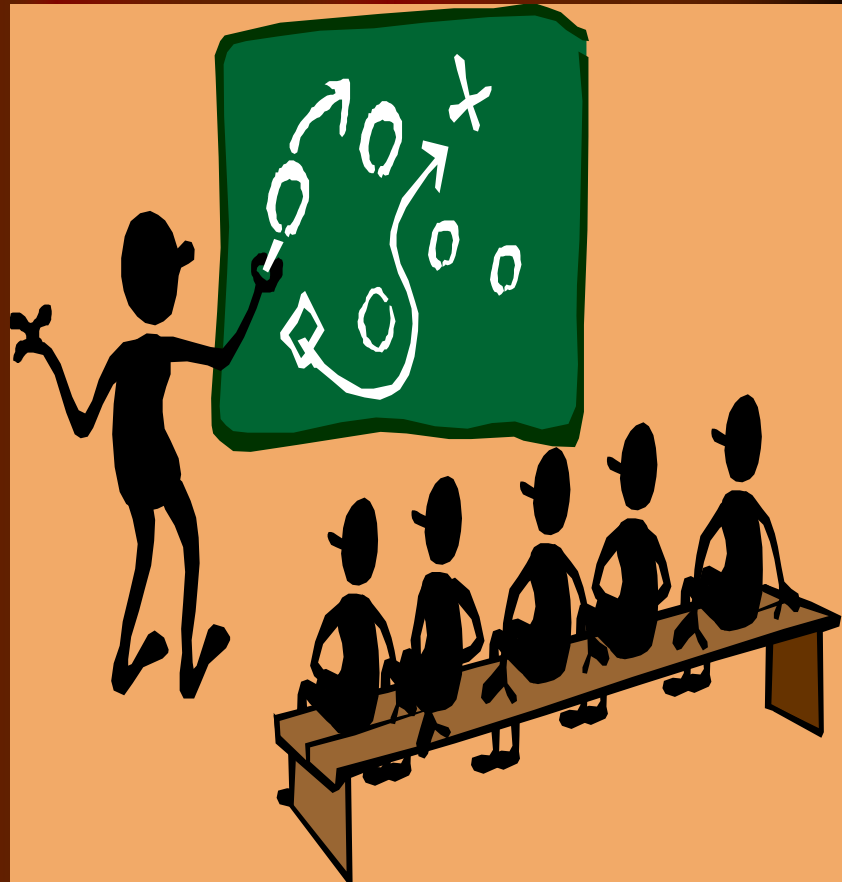
- I graduated from VA TECH

THEN,

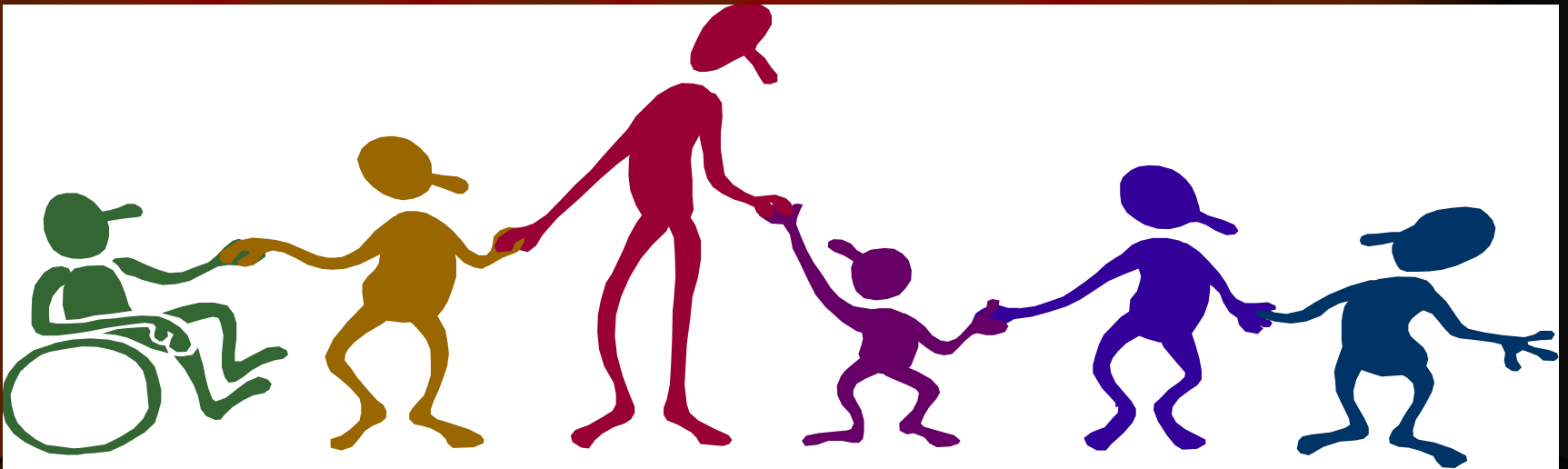
I Decided to become a TEACHER

children.

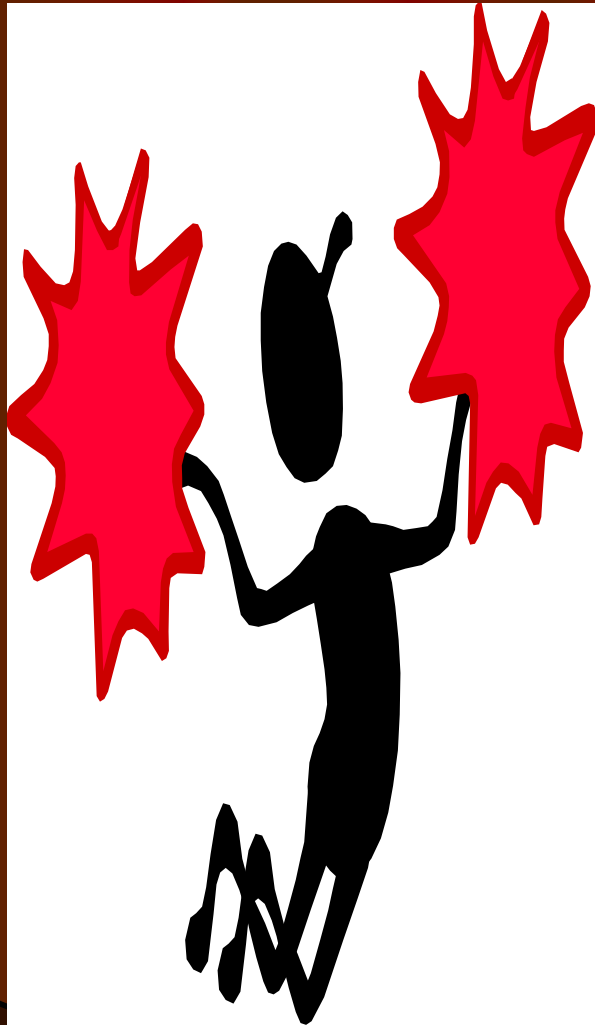


Then . . .

my hard work paid off . . .**



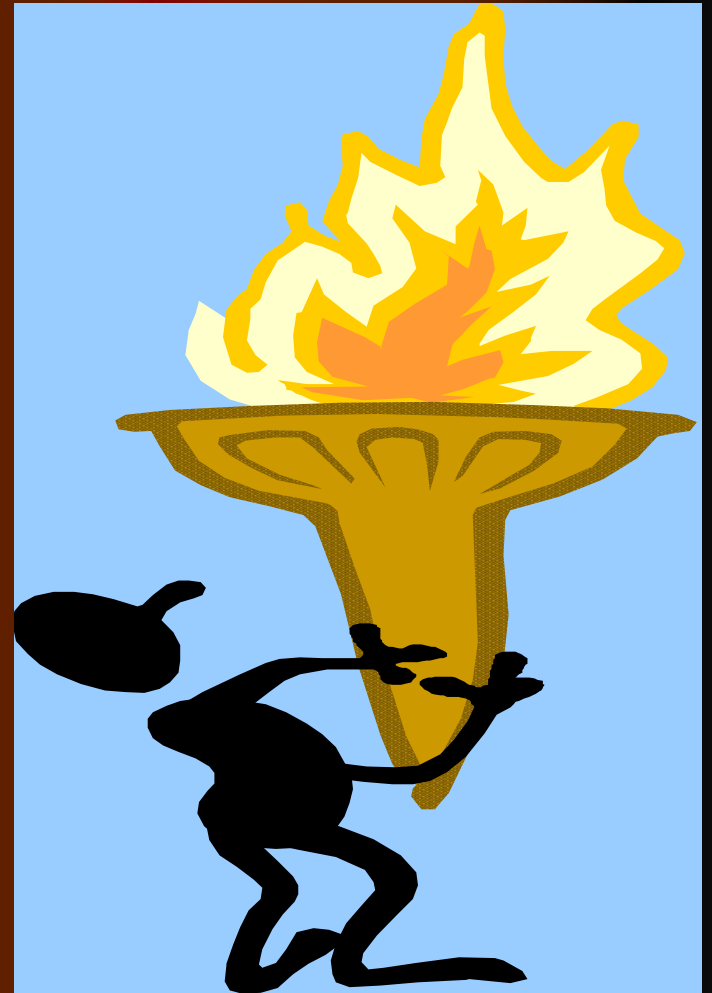
- In 2010, I was appointed Principal of Carver
